

EXTRA SCHOOLS IN AIR SCHEME

Total of 25 Operating in Training Plan For Empire

Ottawa, Sept. 3.—The following is a list of units of the British Commonwealth air training plan which is now in operation and their locations. Acceleration of the program has meant that there are 25 schools of various types operating whereas the original schedule called for only 18. The difference of seven is made up of six additional elementary flying training schools at Fort William, Prince Albert, Lethbridge, London, Windsor, Ont., and Vancouver, and a motor boat crewmen's training school at Trenton.
