


On the 18 December 1944, we departed Giulia Fld, Cerignola, Italy on a Heavy Bombardment mission to Oscoswiscim, Poland. The weather was clear with visibility 15 to 20 miles. We were flying in E-4 position and Lt. Beimbrink and his crew in aircraft 42-51714 was flying in E-5 position on our right side. As we passed over the target we noticed that number 4 engine on Lt Beimbrink's aircraft was smoking slightly although it seemed to be running smothly. The flak over the target was intense and at this time Lt Beimbrink left the formation and that was the last we saw of him.
